



KEY *Cigars*

Travelers can find a wide selection of the world's finest cigars during their visit to Oklahoma City. Several of the City's best cigar shops and lounges are located within close proximity to Oklahoma City hotels. For those who love cigars, we have selected three places that are sure to pique your interest.

The Tinder Box is located in the First National Bank Building in Downtown Oklahoma City. Franchise owner Wayne Castle indicates that Arturo Fuente, Macanudo, and Padrón are consistently some of his best sellers among the downtown crowd. The walk-in humidor has a brick floor and cedar-lined walls. The Tinder Box offers traveling humidors and will ship cigars to its patrons. ZT Cigars can be found on the popular Meridian hotel corridor, four blocks north of I-40. According to general manager Chris Rice, the La Flor Dominicana and Carlos Torano are among ZT's most popular cigars. Constructed with Spanish cedar wood, the walk-in humidor is one of the largest in Oklahoma City. ZT Cigars features a smoking lounge, wi-fi internet service, and will also ship cigars. **Open Monday thru Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Open until 6 p.m. in the Summer.) 304 N. Meridian, Oklahoma City. Maker's Cigar Lounge is located in the Historic Bricktown Entertainment District. Owner Clinton Greenhaw suggests that the Montecristo is a particularly popular cigar amongst his patrons. The brick walls, rich leather furniture, and well-balanced interior lighting create a perfect place to unwind before heading back to the hotel.
